# Background



Feeding Hong Kong is a Hong Kong registered charity established in 2011. Every day, we collect surplus nutritious food from manufacturers, growers, processors, distributors and retailers and deliver it to a network of partner charities, who in turn, provide food to those most in need in Hong Kong. By supporting existing grassroots feeding programmes, we make efficient use of established distribution channels and can focus our own resources on the highest standards in food collection, storage and transportation.

# Our mission



Our mission is to fight hunger in Hong Kong and reduce the amount of quality food that is being sent to our city's landfills. We also work to raise awareness about poverty, food insecurity and food waste in Hong Kong and promote healthy eating and nutritional education to the most vulnerable groups in our community. We are Hong Kong's sole accredited member of the Global Food Banking Network, an international organisation dedicated to creating and strengthening food banks and national food bank networks.

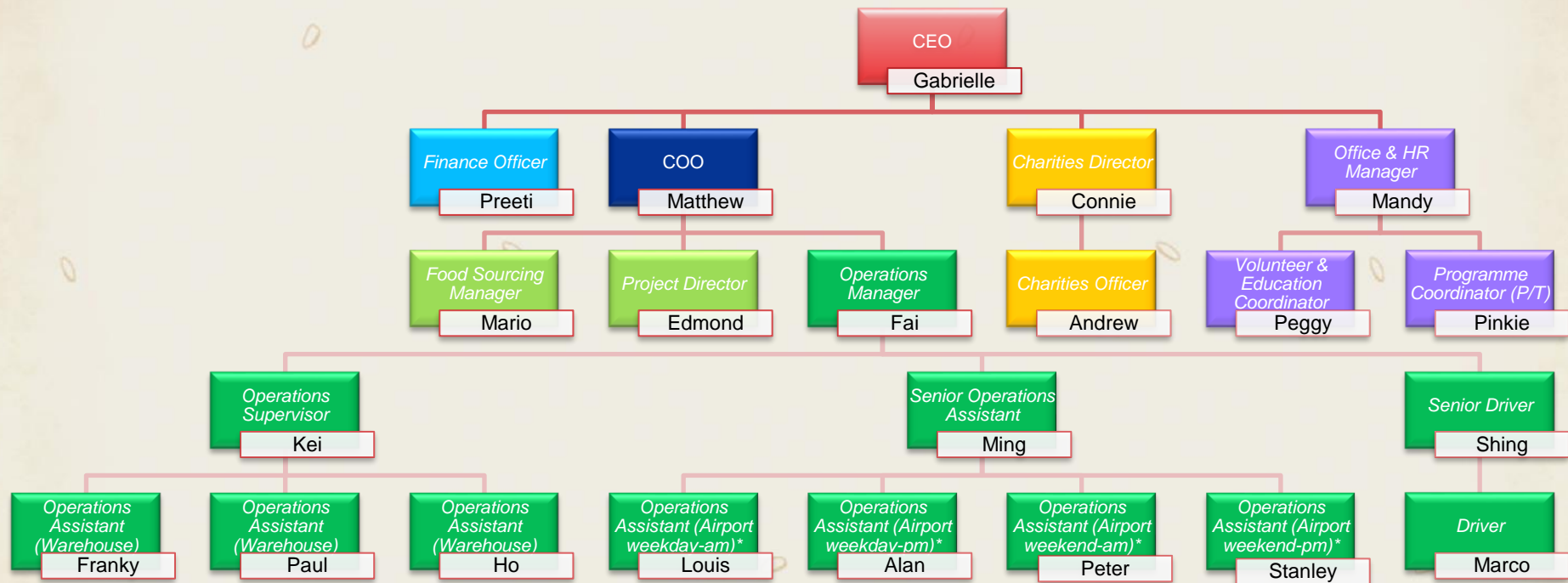

Increased number of food donors  
from 244 to 262

# FHK Airport Programme



Collected 431 tonnes of high quality,  
long-dated surplus food

Donations include cereal boxes, baby  
food, snacks, crackers, fruit juice, UHT  
milk and bottled water

Engaged 48 corporate volunteer groups  
in our weekly warehouse sessions to  
sort, check and repack the donations





# FHK Retail Programme



Partnerships with 4 retail chains to  
rescue surplus stock

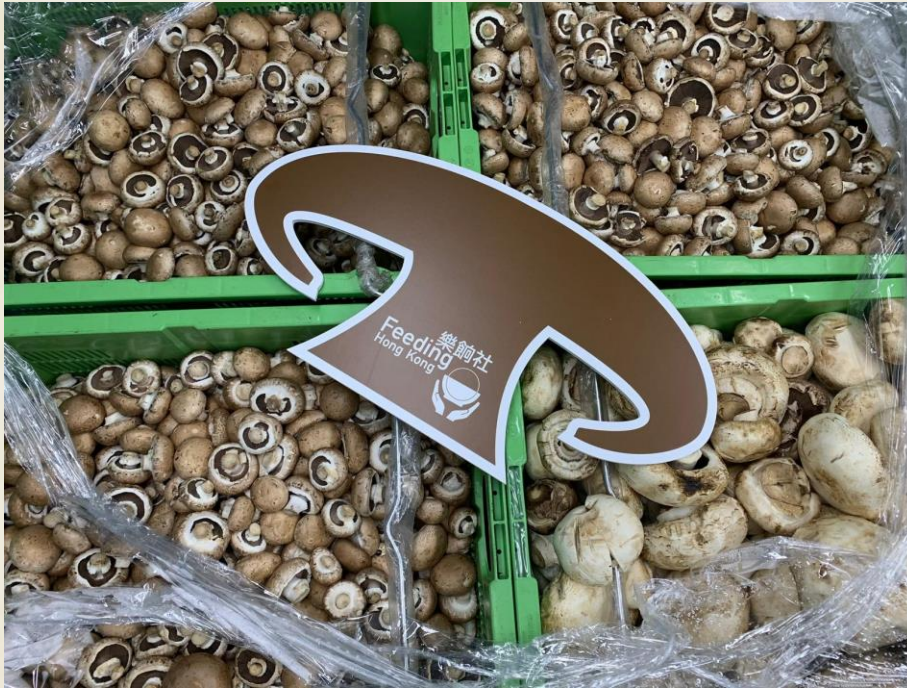
130 retail outlets donating ambient,  
chilled and frozen foods

41 tonnes of nutritious food collected  
and redistributed





# FHK Wholesale Programme



Partnered with 93 food companies to collect multi-pallet, bulk donations

Collected 142 tonnes of fresh, frozen and ambient foods

Donations included 13 tonnes of fresh fruits & vegetables



# FHK Bread Run & Direct Pick-ups



Collected 42 tonnes of fresh bread, sandwiches and salads

Engaged 47 corporate, community and educational volunteer groups

Supported 21 charity food programmes with fresh food





# FHK Festive



Packed and delivered 12,500  
FHK Festive food parcels  
(up from 4,330 food parcels in 2017)

Expanded programme from 1 to 4 festivals:  
CNY, Dragon Boat, Mid-Autumn and Xmas

Engaged 17 corporate and community  
volunteer groups in packing sessions

Hosted Mid-Autumn Festival party with 50  
guests from low income families

# FHK Food Drives



Collected 33 tonnes of long life, shelf-stable food

Partnered with 21 schools and 42 corporate and community groups on food drive

Hosted first Pop-up Foodbank with 6 tonnes of donated food drive products

13 charity partners invited to “shop” for their preferred food items





# FHK Volunteering



Led 304 volunteer activities in support of FHK operations and mission

Volunteers contributed 17,100 manhours of support to the FHK team

Annual FHK Volunteer Gathering held in November to celebrate volunteer contributions

# FHK Education



Led 40 “Meet & Greet” community presentations

Engaged with 3,473 participants from local and overseas schools and companies

Raised public awareness about food waste and food insecurity in HK and the solution of food banking
