Every day, we collect surplus nutritious food from manufacturers, growers, processors, distributors and retailers and deliver it to a network of partner charities, who in turn, provide food to those most in need in Hong Kong. By supporting existing grassroots feeding programmes, we make efficient use of established distribution channels and can focus our own resources on the highest standards in food collection, storage and transportation.

Our mission is to fight hunger in Hong Kong and reduce the amount of quality food that is being sent to our city's landfills. We also work to raise awareness about poverty, food insecurity and food waste in Hong Kong and promote healthy eating and nutritional education to the most vulnerable groups in our community. We Hong Kong's sole accredited member of the Global Food Banking Network, an international organisation dedicated to creating and strengthening food banks and national food bank networks.



Increased number of food donors from 262 to 325 (+24%)

Expanded charity network from 115 to 132 food programmes (+18%)

Increased product rescued from landfill from 700 to 823 tonnes (+18%)

Distributed an extra 66 tonnes of nutritious staples in FHK Festive food parcels (+6%)

Supported 2.17 million meals for local food assistance programmes (+20%)

Maintained cost per meal below HK\$5

FHK Airport Programme





Collected 566 tonnes of high quality, long-dated surplus food

Donations include cereal boxes, baby food, snacks, crackers, fruit juice, UHT milk and bottled water

Engaged 67 corporate volunteer groups in our weekly warehouse sessions to sort, check and repack the donations



FHK Retail Programme





Partnerships with 4 retail chains to rescue surplus stock

127 retail outlets donating ambient, chilled and frozen foods

35 tonnes of nutritious food collected and redistributed



FHK Wholesale Programme





Partnered with 101 food companies to collect multi-pallet, bulk donations

Collected 180 tonnes of fresh, frozen and ambient foods

Donations included 20 tonnes of fresh fruits & vegetables



FHK Bread Run & Direct Pick-ups





Collected 38 tonnes of fresh bread, sandwiches, salads and ready meals

Engaged 55 corporate, community and educational volunteer groups

Supported 39 charity food programmes with fresh food



FHK Festive





Packed and delivered 13,500 FHK Festive food parcels

Expanded programme from 4 to 5 festivals: CNY, Easter, Dragon Boat, Mid-Autumn and Xmas

Engaged 18 corporate and community groups in volunteer packing sessions

Hosted Dragon Boat Festival party with 70 guests from low income families



FHK Food Drives



Collected 35 tonnes of long life, shelf-stable food

Partnered with 90 corporate, community and education groups on food drives

Helped top up surplus donations and increase variety of products distributed



FHK Volunteering





Led 313 volunteer activities in support of FHK operations and mission

Volunteers contributed 19,000+ manhours of support to the FHK team

An average of 150 volunteers per week to feed people, not landfills



FHK Education





Led 40 "Meet & Greet" community presentations

Engaged with 3,493 participants from local and overseas schools and companies

Raised public awareness about food waste and food insecurity in HK and the solution of food banking
